CPH has launched the Book of Concord Online: a free, easy-to-use website that provides access to the Lutheran Confessions at bookofconcord.cph.org.

This platform was thoughtfully designed to support pastors, educators, and laypeople who desire to study and confess the Lutheran Confessions with clarity and confidence.

While other websites featuring the Triglotta are currently available, the CPH version features the text of *Concordia: The Lutheran Confessions*, the most widely used and trusted version in the LCMS for more than twenty years.

Ash Wednesday is coming up on February 18.

Please make note of the following:

1. We will have the door open 30 minutes for service so that anyone who wishes to pray and meditate on the examination questions may do so.
2. We will also do the ashes before the service starting at about 6:50 until 7. So, please come a little early if you would like ashes. Pastor and/or and elder will be up front to place ashes on those who want ashes at that time.
3. If you have palm branches saved from last year, please bring them to pastor by February 15 so that they can be burned in preparation and use for Ash Wednesday.

During Lent, after the Ash Wednesday Service and before the Palm Sunday Service, we will take time at every service to pray for around 15-20 members of the congregation until we have prayed once as a congregation for every member of the congregation.

A list will be created so that you can also pray for those members at home. If you have anything special you would like included in those prayers, please let pastor, Jeremiah, or an elder know.
